

The Historical Society of Phillipston Presents Project Mishoon

Tuesday, April 18th at 7:00 PM Location: Phillipston Fire Department

In 2000, a recreational diver found a sunken dugout canoe, or mishoon, in Worcester's Lake Quinsigamond. Knowing that their Nipmuc ancestors used the dugout to navigate the lake, the Hassanamisco Nipmuc tribe secured a reconnaissance permit with the Massachusetts Board of Underwater Archeological Resources in 2001. Subsequently, two additional mishoon were found, one dating to the 1640s. These unusual mishoon are unlike any others previously identified in New England. Cheryl Stedtler, Nipmuc tribal member and director of Project Mishoon, will present information on the mishoonash, including their history, scientific documentation and underwater imaging.

Following the presentation we will visit the Society's museum to view Phillipston's canoe that was found in Queen Lake in 1967.
