

2010 Queen Lake Ice-Out Rules

1. All rules will be made by majority of the full 2010 Queen Lake Ice-Out Committee whose decisions will be final.
2. Any disputes to the rules or situations not covered by the rules will be taken under consideration by the Committee and their decision will be final.
3. The first prize winner will be the ticket that is closest to the day, hour, minute and second to the validated time on the official clock. Closest can be over or under validated time. In case of a tie, the first prize will be split among the winners.
4. After the first prize has been awarded, other prizes will be awarded based on the next closest guess to the day, hour, minute and second to the validated time on the official clock (over or under). In case of a tie, see No. 10 below.
5. Winners will be notified as soon as possible after the sink time is validated.
6. If the Queen cannot be put on the lake due to lack of ice, or any other reason, all valid tickets will be put in a container. The President of the Historical Society will draw the winners in the order of 1st prize to the last prize. Winners need not be present at the drawing.
7. If only the day of the melting through the ice can be determined, all tickets for that day will be put in a container and drawn as in rule 6.
8. If only the day and the hour of melting through the ice can be determined, only tickets for that day and hour will be placed in the container and drawn as in rule 6.
9. If only the day, hour and minute of melting through the ice can be determined, only tickets for that day, hour and minute will be place in the container and drawn as in rule 6.
10. For any ties for prizes other than the 1st prize, the tickets will be put into a container and the winner will be drawn by the President of the Society, the remaining ticket(s) will win the next lesser prize(s). Winners need not be present at the drawing.
11. Only tickets that have been paid in full, submitted by March 1, 2010 and certified as valid will be eligible to win any prizes. No late entries will be accepted.
12. People who purchase multiple tickets are eligible for multiple prizes.
13. Everyone is eligible to purchase tickets including historical society members and their families, Queen Lake Ice-Out committee members and their families, and Queen Lake Ice-Out sponsors and their families.
14. Entries received after March 1, 2010, will be ineligible. It is your responsibility to give us your complete contact information and the complete date, hour, minute, second, am or pm of your guess as to when the Queen will sink..
15. Ice-Out Ticket Default Policy - It is **your** responsibility to fill out the tickets appropriately with the date and complete time. However – Incomplete tickets will be handled thus: Any minutes or seconds not specified will be “00”. Any AM/PM not specified will be: Hours 12 and 1 to 5 will be PM. Hours 6 to 11 will be AM. If a day or hour is not specified, a committee member will **attempt** to contact you **only if we have time**. If we do not contact you, we thank you for the donation.
