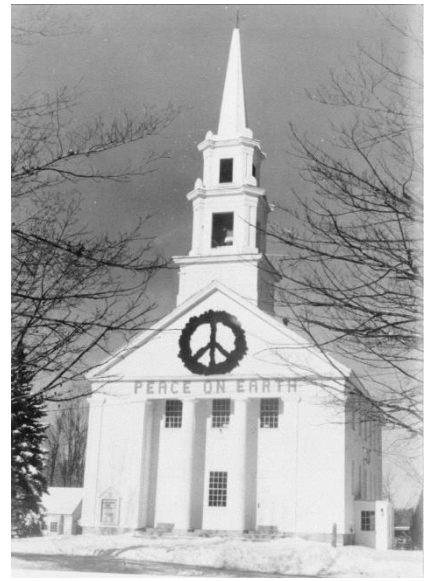
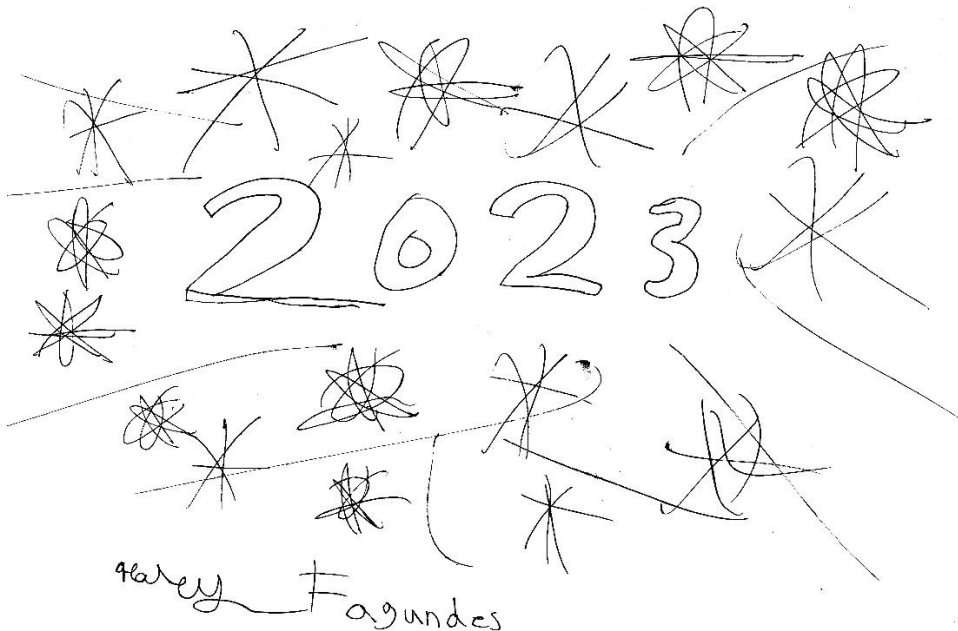

Dear Friends,

I received a Christmas card with a picture of lovely iced branches with berries on them. We see a great deal of ice in January. Ice can lock away food for small birds. The food is there but not available for the birds to eat. If the situation lasts long, the birds can starve. In contrast, the promises of God are there for all. We believe that God is able to do what He promises. Like the ice which locks away food for the birds, unbelief locks away God's promises, so they are not available. (James 1: 5-7) We are now in the Christmas and Epiphany seasons, a great time to remember the promises God has made and realize they are His gifts to us. "For God so loved the world, that he gave His only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life." Symptoms of rabies may include unexplained aggression, impaired locomotion, varying degrees of paralysis, and extreme depression or viciousness. Individual animals maybe affected in different ways. Some animals will display the well known "vicious" form, while others, displaying the "dumb" form, will merely appear sick or dazed and become very lethargic. Once an animal begins to show signs of rabies it is likely to die within 5 days. All dogs must wear a collar or harness with their tag or identification.

BOARD OF HEALTH
TRANSFER STICKER PROGRAM

The current Transfer Station stickers will expire on 12/31/22

Effective **January 1, 2023** ALL vehicles using the Town of Phillipston Transfer Station **MUST** have a Board of Health issued Transfer Station Sticker attached to their vehicle. By January 31st you need to have the new **YELLOW** sticker, this will allow additional time to get it.

1. The sticker will cost \$40.00 for two years. Checks only, no cash accepted. Checks payable to the Town of Phillipston.
2. Additional stickers for the same household will be \$5.00
3. Only two additional stickers will be allowed per household.

There are two ways to obtain a sticker(s) for your car.

1. Stickers are available at the Board of Health office located in the Town Annex across from the Town Hall, Wednesdays from 3:00 – 5:00 pm. You must have your car registration(s) and proof of residency if different from registration. Will also be open Saturday January 7, 2023 from 9am to Noon.
2. Mail your payment by check or money order payable to: Town of Phillipston, to the Board of Health at 50 The Common, Phillipston, MA 01331, with a copy of your car registration(s), proof of residency and a stamped self-addressed return envelope. We will process your request and mail the sticker(s) back to you.

Upon receipt of your sticker you need to attach it to your vehicle.

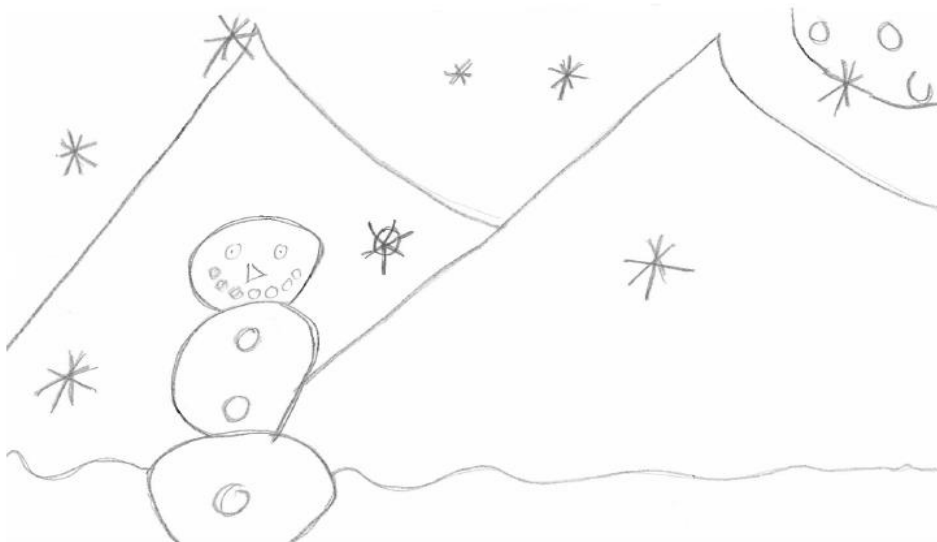
