Dear Friends,

Many years ago I read in the United Church of Christ Christian Educator's Newsletter spiritual practices for the weeks of Lent. This article was adapted from Church Education, December 1996, Prescott Arizona. The main idea is instead of giving up something for Lent, is to adapt love giving for Lent.

Week of March 9 Share your love by writing at least two notes or sending two cards telling the recipients how much you appreciate them. Include someone you might not normally think to say this to.

Week of March 16 Telephone or visit with two or three people, just to chat and tell them what they mean to you, or to say "Thank you" or "I'm sorry." Make an effort to include someone who you've intended to contact but somehow never have. (Read 1 Corinthians 13)

Week of March 23 Take a small gift to a neighbor or shut in. Or do a small fix it job for an elderly person. The important thing is to offer yourself gladly. (Read 1 Corinthians again)

Week March 30 Make a list of 10 people to pray for daily. Include someone you don't get along with very well. Forgive if she or he has wronged you or ask for forgiveness if you have wronged him or her. (Read 1 John 4: 7-21)

Week April 6 Pray for yourself this week. Ask God to search your heart and reveal changes you need to make in your life. (Read 1 John 4: 17-21 again.)

Week of April 13 This is the week of celebration. Do something special with your family. Perhaps go to the Living Last Supper in Athol. Attend Easter Worship on Sunday, April 20.


